Registration, Submission and Tracking of Competition Entries

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This manual is intended for participants of the international competition "Together Against Corruption!" and describes how to use the participant's personal account: getting registered on the website, logging in, submitting competition entries, tracking verification and publication statuses of entries, receiving notifications and the participant's certificate, as well as viewing the competition results.

Any individual, their representative (for example, a parent or teacher of a minor author) or a creative group may participate in the competition. Public sections of the website (about the competition, rules, news, gallery, results) are available to all visitors without registration. To submit entries and access the personal account, registration and logging in are required.

Registration and Logging in

Registration

To create an account, click the "Personal Account" link on the main page and select "Registration", or go to /register/. The registration form consists of three consecutive steps (tabs): "Personal Information", "Contact Information" and "Security". Navigation between steps is performed using the "Next" and "Back" buttons; mandatory fields are marked with an asterisk.

Step 1 "Personal Information" (Figure 1). The following information is provided at this step:

- participant type – "Individual", "Individual's Representative" or "Creative Group";
- surname, first name and patronymic;
- date of birth (selected in the calendar).

For the "Individual's Representative" type, the representative's details (for example, a parent or teacher) and the author-participant's details are additionally entered; for "Creative Group", the group's name and the list of its members are entered.

Step 2 "Contact Information" (Figure 2). The following information is provided at this step:

- email address – used as the login for signing in;
- phone number;
- country;
- constituent entity of the Russian Federation (for participants from Russia);
- city;

- place of work or study;
- position held.

Step 3 "Security" (Figure 3). At this step, it is necessary to:

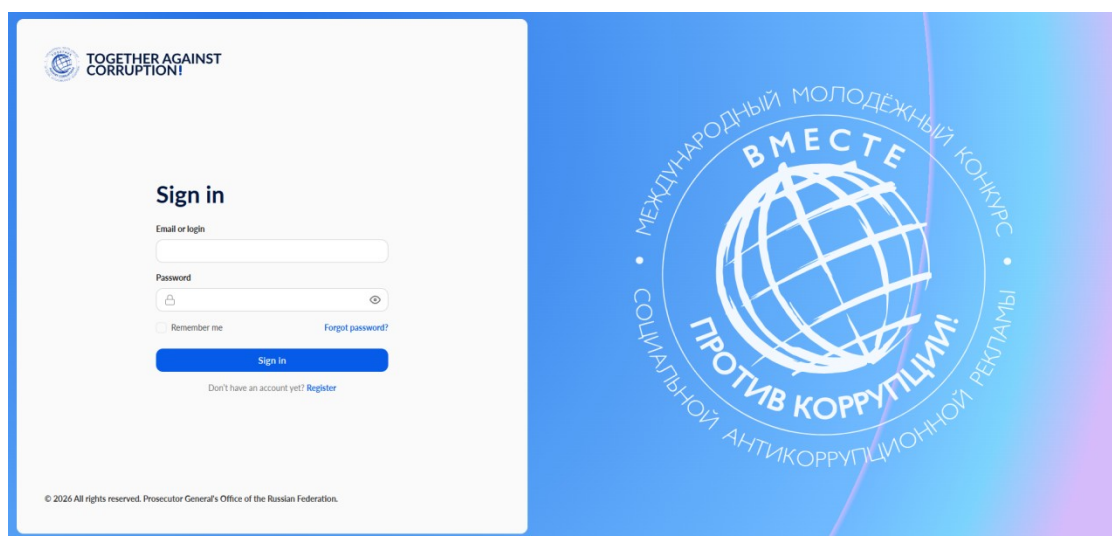
- set a password (at least 8 characters) and reintroduce it;
- enter the digits from the picture (protection against automated registration);
- consent to the processing of personal data and accept the competition rules.

After clicking the "Register" button, a confirmation email is sent to the specified email address. Until confirmation is completed, logging in may be unavailable.

Logging In

To log in, follow the "Personal Account" link or go to /login/, enter the email address and password, and click the "Log In" button (Figure 4). The "Show Password" button allows you to check that the password is entered correctly. If you forget your password, use the "Forgot your password?" link – instructions for resetting it will be sent to your email.

After logging in, the personal account opens to the "General Information" section (Figure 5). The side menu provides access to the "General Information", "My Entries", "Notifications" and "Participant's Certificate" sections.

The "General Information" section displays the participant's profile: photo, surname, first name and patronymic, "Participant" status, email address, phone number, age, position held, place of work or study, country and city. The "Edit Profile" button opens a form for modifying this information; the "Change Profile Photo" button opens photo upload.

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Below on the page, recent entries and recent notifications are displayed, and on the right side there is the "Upload Entry" panel with the nomination selection and information on the competition timeline (progress, entry submission period, number of published entries).

Submitting a Competition Entry

A competition entry is submitted in one of three nominations:

- "Poster" – graphic design with an anti-corruption message;
- "Drawing" – artistic illustration on combating corruption;
- "Video" – video message on transparency and honesty.

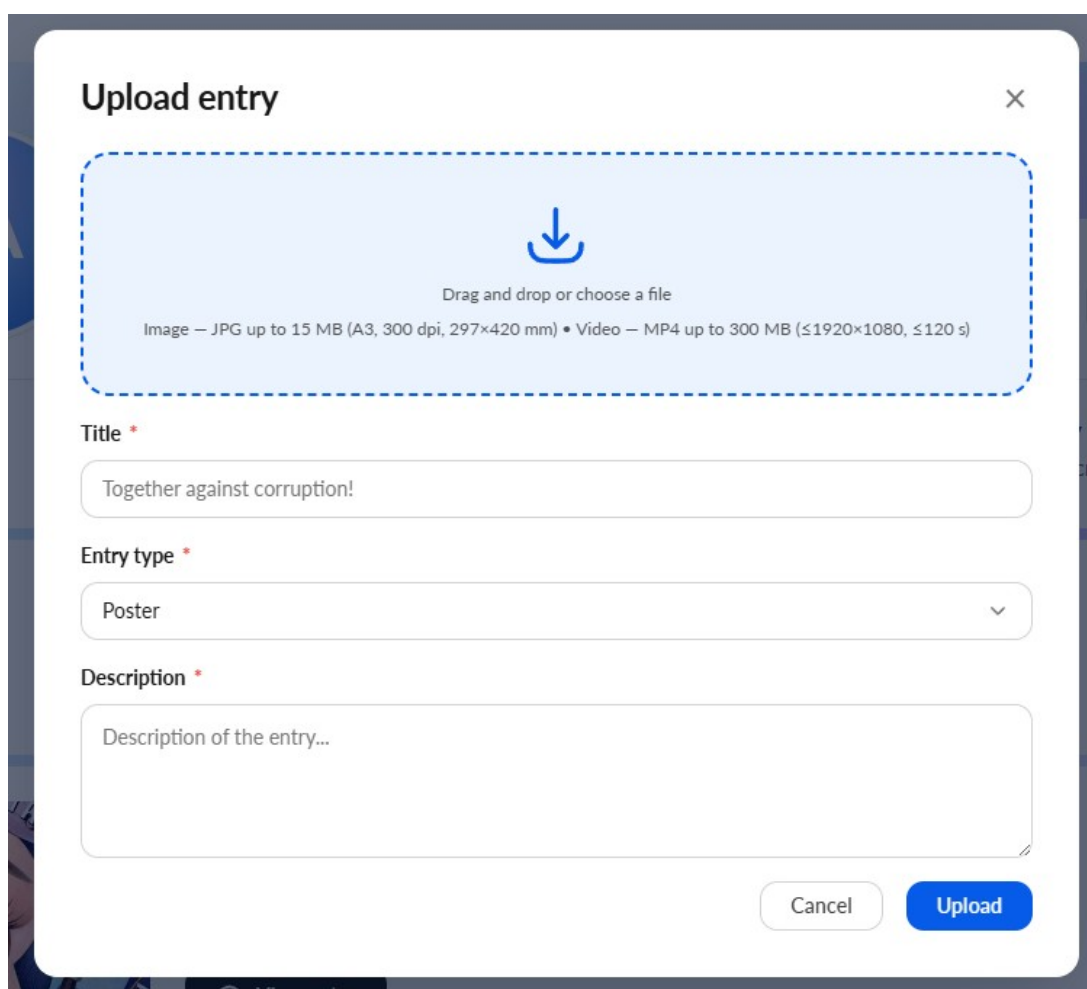


Figure 6 – Competition entry upload window

To submit an entry, select the desired nomination in the "Upload Entry" block on the right side of the personal account and click the "Submit Entry" button. The entry upload window will open (Figure 6).

In the upload window, the following actions are required:

1. drag and drop the entry file into the designated area or select it on your computer.

File requirements: images – JPG format (A3, 300 dpi, 297×420 mm, file size up to 15 MB);

video – MP4 format (frame size up to 1920×1080, duration no more than 120 seconds, file size up to 300 MB);

2. set the title of the entry (mandatory field);
3. select the type of entry (poster, drawing or video);
4. enter a description of the entry;
5. click the "Upload" button (to cancel, use the "Cancel" button).

Once uploaded, the entry automatically undergoes an originality check (anti-plagiarism). The progress and result of the verification are displayed in the "My Entries" section and in notifications. Until the submission deadline, participants may submit multiple entries.

My Entries and Verification Statuses

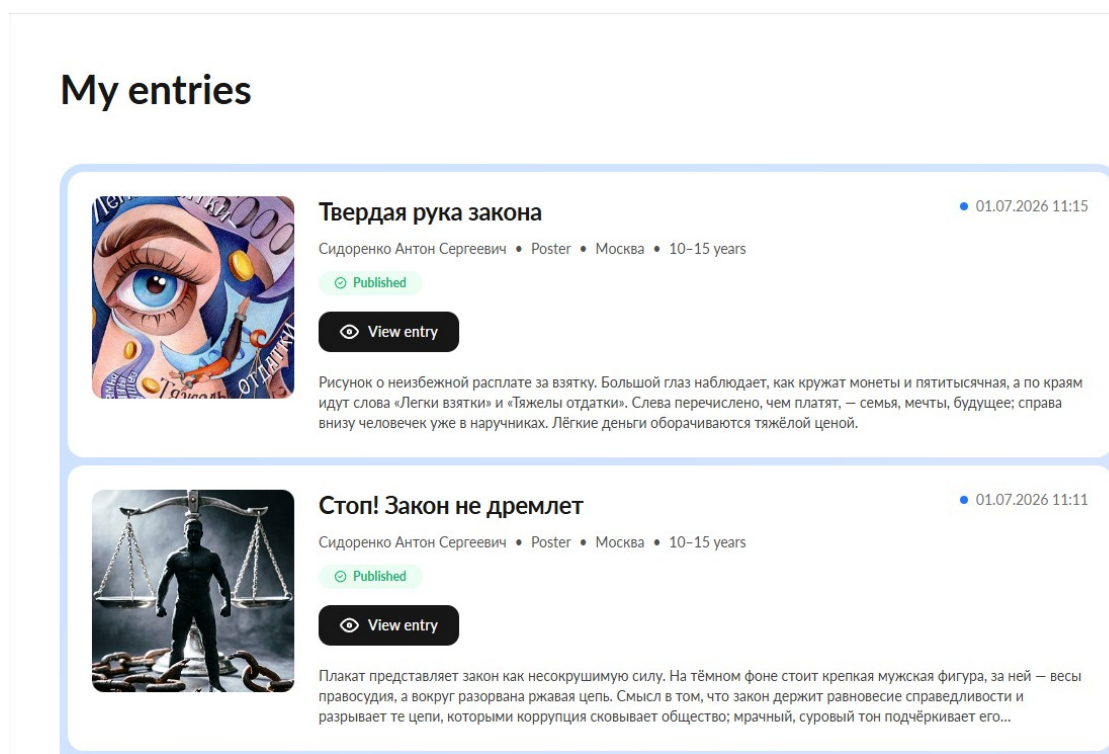


Figure 7 – "My Entries" Section

The "My Entries" section contains a list of all submitted entries, indicating the title, type, author's age group, submission date and current statuses (Figure 7).

For each entry, the upload status, verification result and publication status are displayed. Each entry may have one of the following statuses:

- "Uploaded" – the entry has been accepted and queued for verification;
- "Published" – the entry has passed verification and has been published in the competition entries evaluation section;

– "Failed moderation" – the entry did not pass moderation and is not admitted to participation.

To view detailed information about an entry, use the "View Entry" link (Figure 8). The entry page displays its image or video, basic information (title, type, submission date) and statuses.

Notifications

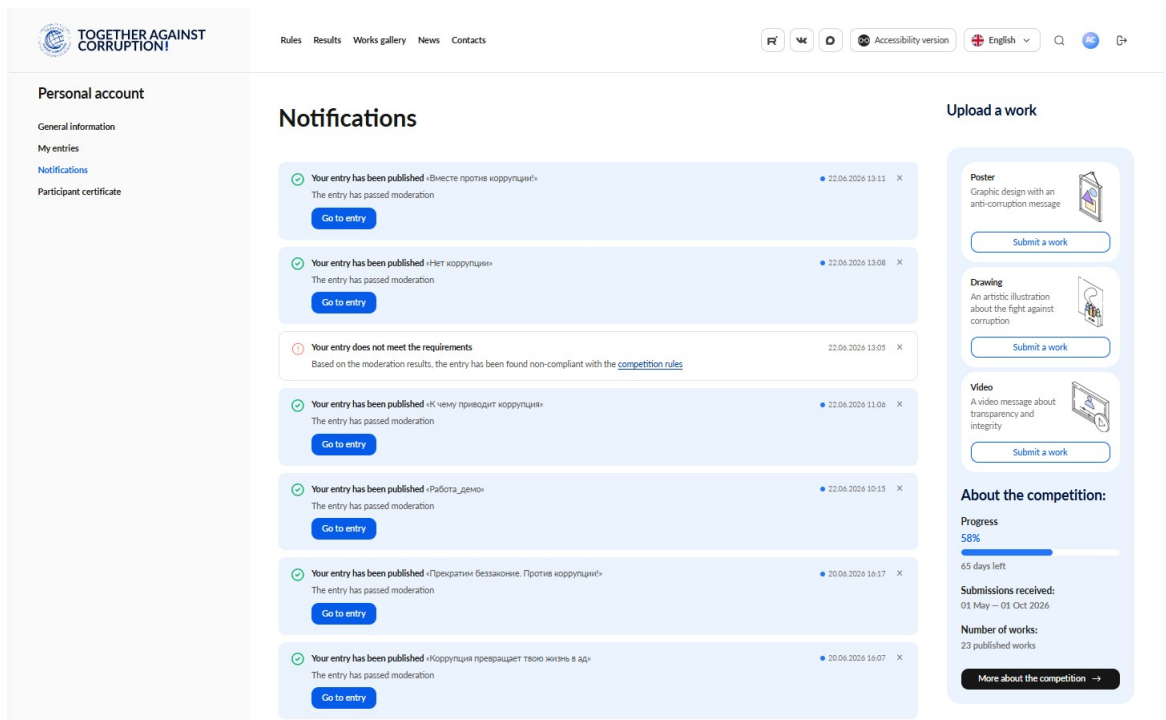


Figure 9 – "Notifications" Section

The "Notifications" section contains messages about key events concerning the participant's entries (Figure 9):

- entry queued for verification;
- entry submitted for moderation;
- entry passed moderation;
- entry rejected following moderation.

Read notifications can be hidden using the close button.

Participant's Certificate

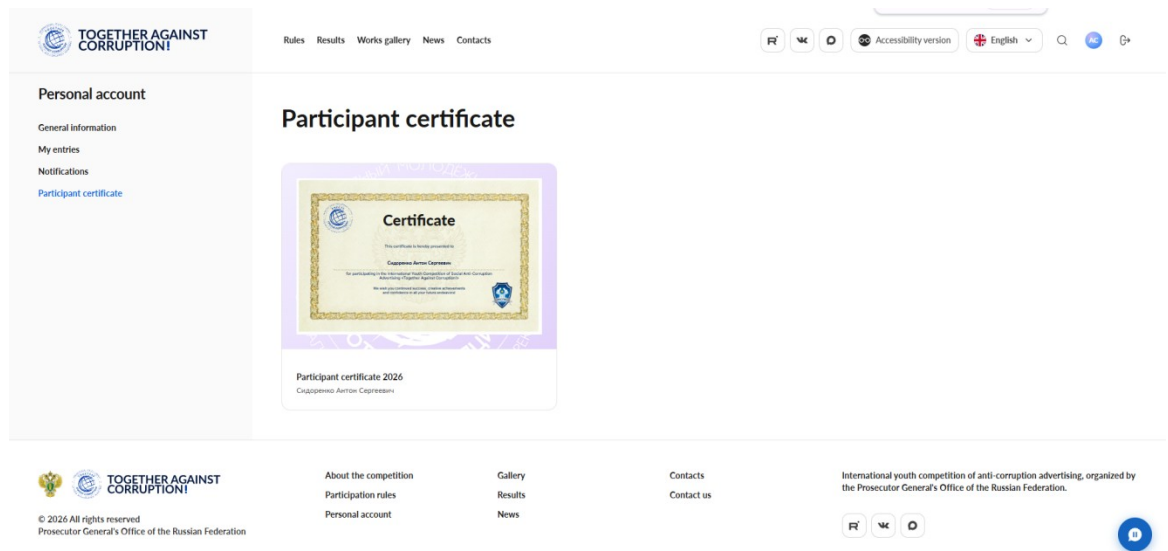


Figure 10 – "Participant's Certificate" Section

The "Participant's Certificate" section provides access to a personal certificate for participation in the competition (Figure 10). The certificate can be viewed, saved to your computer and printed.

The certificate is issued automatically. Within a year, a participant receives one certificate regardless of the number of entries submitted. The certificate indicates the participant's name, and for a creative group – the group's name.

Competition Results

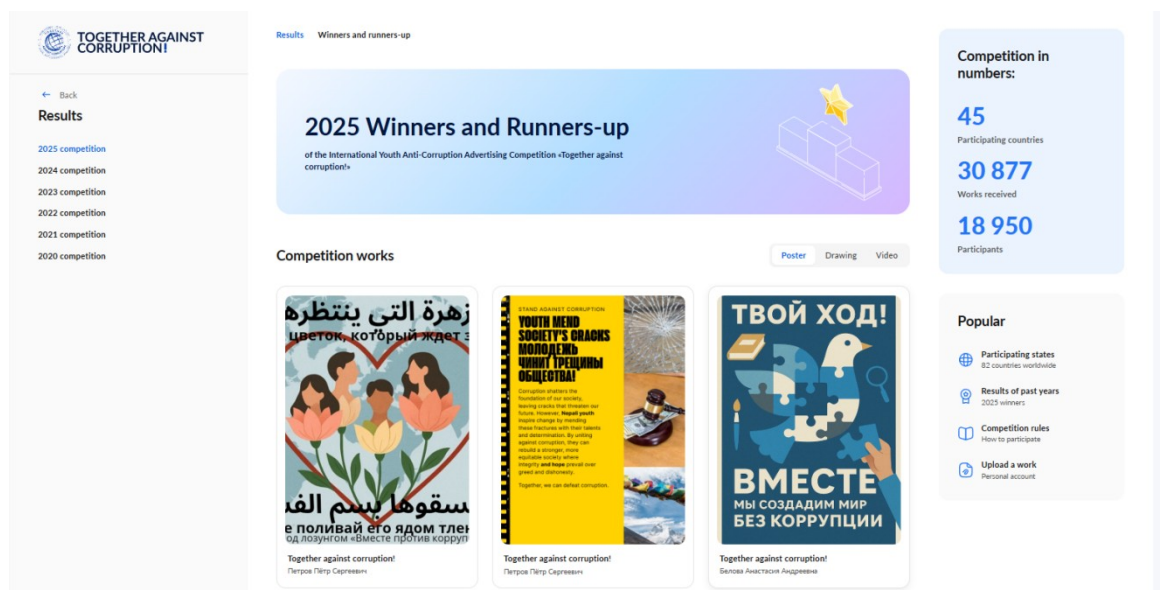


Figure 11 – "Results" Page

The results of the competition and the winning entries are published on the official competition website in the "Results" section, accessible from the top menu of the site (Figure 11). This section is available to all visitors without logging in; and allows viewing the winning entries by nomination and by year.
